Only **70 km** to the EU border



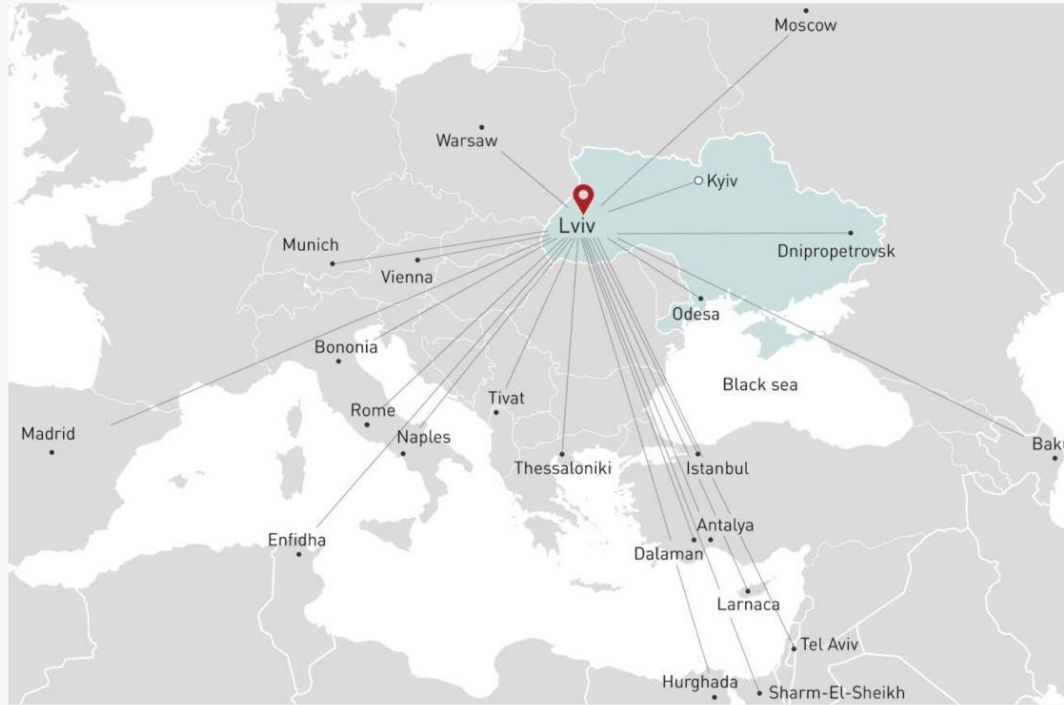

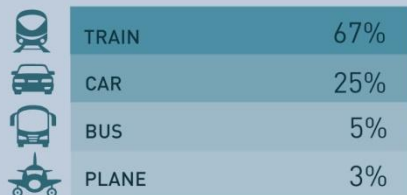
The Old Town of Lviv is a UNESCO World Heritage Site

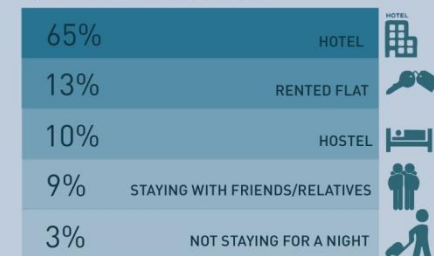
MEANS OF TRANSPORTATION TO LVIV



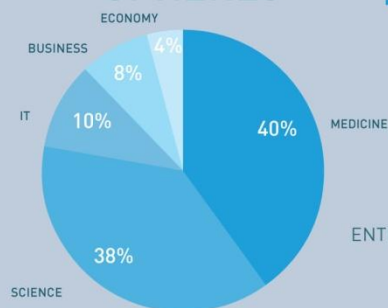

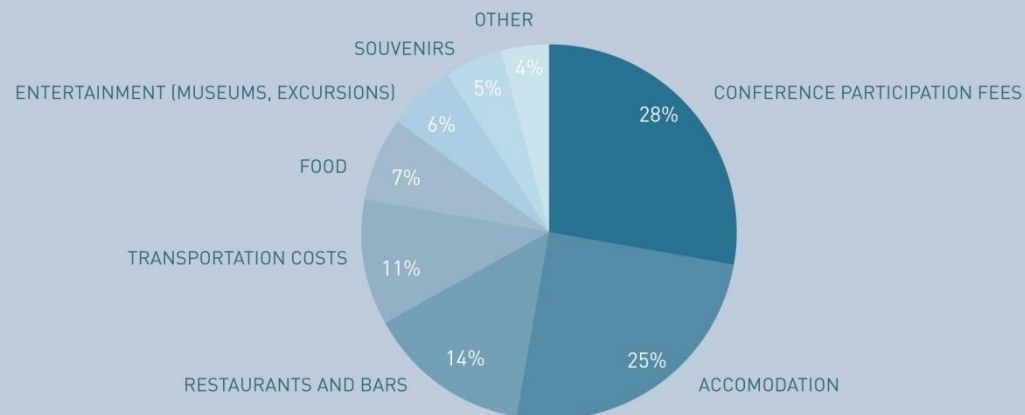
